CHAPTER 50: GARBAGE AND RUBBISH

§ 50.01 DUMPING RUBBISH AND THE LIKE ON ANY PREMISES PROHIBITED; EXCEPTIONS.

Except as provided in the provisions of this chapter regulating the collection and removal of garbage and tin cans, it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation, its officers or agents, to dump, deposit or drop on any premises within the village any tin cans, rubbish, refuse or other waste products unless the same is placed upon some dumping ground licensed under this chapter; provided that, a person, in the operation of his or her business or in connection with the maintenance of his or her home, may deposit or place or cause to be deposited or placed upon premises owned by him or her waste products temporarily for the purpose of removal to a dumping ground or for regular village collection; provided further that, the temporary depositing shall not become offensive to human beings or detrimental to public health.

§ 50.02 DEPOSITING LITTER IN PUBLIC PLACES.

No person shall deposit or cause to be deposited any litter on any street, sidewalk, alley, public or private property, except on approved private or public dumps.

§ 50.03 DUTY OF PROPERTY OWNERS TO KEEP PREMISES FREE FROM LITTER.

It shall be the duty of the owner or person in control of any premises, vacant or occupied, to keep his or her premises, sidewalks and all adjoining public property between the center of street and center of alley free of litter at all times. All litter removed shall be placed in proper receptacles or removed to an approved disposal location.

§ 50.04 COLLECTION OF RUBBISH AND THE LIKE.

No collector, person, firm or corporation shall collect garbage in the village, without first obtaining a license or permit for the collection of same and no license shall be granted any collector unless the collector first enters into a formal contract with the village. The collection schedule, equipment, vehicles, personnel, disposal, insurance and sanitary conditions of the collector must meet with the approval of the Village Council, or its duly authorized representative, at all times.

§ 50.99 PENALTY.

A violation of any provision of this chapter shall constitute a municipal civil infraction and shall be handled in accordance with Chapter 33 of this code.
